

Did you purchase Hydrogen Peroxide directly from a Distributor or Manufacturer of Hydrogen Peroxide in Canada between Nov 1, 1998 and Dec 31, 2003?

If so, apply now to receive money from a class action settlement.

WHAT IS A CLASS ACTION?

A class action is a lawsuit filed by one person on behalf of a large group of people with the same concerns.

ABOUT THIS CLASS ACTION

The Plaintiffs allege that between November 1, 1998 and December 31, 2003, the defendants, FMC Corporation and FMC of Canada, Ltd. (collectively, "FMC"), and co-conspirators conspired to raise, fix, maintain, or stabilize prices for Hydrogen Peroxide and allocate markets and customers for the sale of Hydrogen Peroxide. FMC denies these allegations.

Previous settlements totaling CDN\$20.6 million were reached with five other groups of defendants. Those settlement funds have been previously distributed.

An additional settlement totaling CDN\$3.25 million was recently reached with FMC. The settlement was approved by the Ontario court and was declared applicable and enforceable by the British Columbia court. The settlement is a compromise of disputed claims and is not an admission of liability.

The settlement resolves the class action in its entirety.

HOW MUCH WILL I RECEIVE?

The settlement funds (plus accrued interest and less approved fees and expenses) are available for distribution to eligible claimants.

The settlement funds will be distributed to eligible claimants proportionately based on the value of the claimant's Notional Entitlement, as compared to the value of all qualifying claimants' Notional Entitlement.

A claimant's Notional Entitlement will be calculated based on the categorization of the claimant's purchases and the amount of eligible Hydrogen Peroxide purchases they made between November 1, 1998 and December 31, 2003.

AM I ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE MONEY?

You are eligible to receive money if between November 1, 1998 and December 31, 2003 you purchased Hydrogen Peroxide directly from a distributor or eligible manufacturer of Hydrogen Peroxide in Canada.

DO I NEED PROOF OF PURCHASE?

Where possible, you can rely on sales records provided by the defendants. If you did not purchase directly from a defendant or sales data is not available, you may be required to provide purchase records.

HOW DO I APPLY TO RECEIVE SETTLEMENT BENEFITS?

It does not cost anything to apply to receive a payment. Counsel fees have been approved by the court and will be paid out of the settlement funds.

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE FOR APPLYING TO RECEIVE PAYMENTS?

Applications must be made no later than, September, 3, 2019

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY MONEY?

Accurate processing takes time. Depending on the number of applications filed, it could be up to one year before you receive compensation. Please check www.hydrogenperoxideclassaction.ca for regular updates.
